Family Involvement Policy

At Hall Elementary School, we believe that cooperation and communication between school and home are important for all students to be successful. Hall Elementary School is committed to providing an environment where families feel needed and their suggestions are valued.

In keeping with the above commitment, Hall Elementary School will:

- Host an annual Open House/Back-to-School night that will allow families to meet their child's teacher, receive information about curricula, see their child(ren)'s classroom, and hear about important things going on at Hall Elementary School and in the Gresham-Barlow School District.
- Schedule student conferences in the fall that will allow parents to collaborate with teachers on important decisions concerning their child's education, receive information about the student's progress, receive information about the school's Title I program, and receive information about their rights to be involved in their child's education.
- Regularly distribute (in Spanish and English) a newsletter, the Hall Happenings, that announces meeting dates for PTC, DAC, Family Nights and Site Council. All parents are welcome at these meetings. The newsletter will also contain other school-related information such as parenting tips, and information on family involvement activities and programs. These may include Family Nights, Book Fairs, volunteer trainings, Title I informational meetings, SUN program, annual Open House, etc.)
- Communicate with students' families through the Hall School Handbook, Title I information letters, report cards, conferences, etc.
- Where practicable, send communications to parents in a language that the parent understands as determined by the Home Language Survey.
- Design and communicate a student/school/parent compact that outlines how responsibility for each child's education will be shared.
