Frequently Asked Questions

Q. What is Title I?

A. Title 1 is a federally funded program that provides supplemental support in the areas of reading, writing, and math. At Hall Elementary School Title I is a School-Wide Program. This means all students at Hall are entitled to receive services. Title I encourages parents and families to actively participate in the education of their children.

Q. How does Title I work at Hall School?

A. There are many programs at Hall that are supported by Title I funds. For example:


Reading Specialist - we have a full time reading teacher to support staff and students with Hall's School-wide Title I Program.

Student Support Specialist - we have a full time reading teacher supporting small groups at all grade levels in reading, math, and behavior interventions.

Educational Assistants - There are 5 Title 1 assistant positions in our building, approximately one assistant for every 3 classrooms.

Literacy Program - The Reading Specialist and Title I Assistants provide added support in K, 1st, 2nd, and 3rd grades.

Reading Connection ~ is a parent newsletter that is sent home monthly with students. It is available in both Spanish and English.

Books and Materials ~ When funds are available, books and resource materials are purchased to enhance the learning of the students at Hall School. Title I has been able to purchase classroom sets of chapter books and various supplemental reading materials.

Family Nights ~ Title I participates in and provides support for Family Nights. Families are encouraged to share in these fun-filled evenings with a targeted focus, theme, and activities.

RTI (Response to Intervention) ~ Title I participates in the RTI model of intervention services, offering targeted intervention support to small groups for 30-45 minutes each day in grades K, 1st, 2nd, and 3rd grades.
